Completing Verifone Documents for *Point* Service

In order to sign up for Point service with Verifone, WordStock user stores need to complete and email three forms to Verifone:

- 1. **Point Service Merchant Agreement**, a 'pdf' document:
- 2. **ACH Authorization Form**, a 'pdf' document; and This document is intended to help you to complete and submit the forms. If you need assistance completing theforms, please email **John McDowell**, WordStock Support, at **johnm@wordstock.com** or call **800-444-7224**, **opt 1**.

1. Point Service Merchant Agreement

The *Point Service Merchant Agreement* sets out all the terms and conditions of renting Point software and hardware from Verifone.

If you'll be renting the terminal from Verifone, you'll need to complete two sections of the 'STANDARD MERCHANT AGREEMENT FOR VERIFONE POINT SOLUTION': the Merchant identifying information and the "Rental Devices" section on page 1; and the Merchant information and signature section on page 3.

If you'll be using Verifone for service only, because you own a terminal, you'll need to complete a different version of the 'STANDARD MERCHANT AGREEMENT FOR VERIFONE POINT SOLUTION': look for a notation in red type at the top of page one that says "Services only device rental not included." Complete the Merchant identifying information on pages 1 and 3.

Each WordStock POS register will need to have a Verifone MX925 terminal running *Point*; the basic monthly rental fee, per unit, is \$35.00.In addition,there are four options that we recommend you consider:

- **Priority Exchange** A hardware maintenance program whereby Verifone will send you a replacement unit if you have an inoperable MX925 terminal; to minimize downtime, the replacement will be sent prior to Verifone receiving the problem unit; fee: \$1.50/month.
- PCI/SAQ PCI/SAQ Tool is a service, provided by a third party company, ControlScan, to help

merchants complete the required *Payment Card Industry Self-Assessment Questionnaire*, or 'PCI/SAQ.' fee: \$3.0/month.

• Low contour stand - A device for holding the Verifone MX925 securely at the POS, rather than having it rest directly on the POS counter. fee: \$2.25/month.

Monthly fees for the base rental and recommended options are:

MX 925 Base unit, per POS	35.00
Priority Exchange	1.50
PCI/SAQ	3.00
Low contour stand	2.25

Total, per POS, w/options \$41.76

2. ACH Authorization Form

"ACH" stands for Automated Clearing House and refers to electronic payments transferred directly from one bank account to another. The *ACH Authorization Form* confirms that you will pay your monthly Verifone rental fees via electronic transfer. There are two sections of the *ACH Authorization Form* that you need to complete, highlighted in the illustration at right:

- The bank account information at the top of the page;
- The information for the authorized account representative(s).

The **ACH Authorization Form** will open in the Adobe *Acrobat Reader* program included with your web browser(s). Enter information into the various blank areas and then 'sign'the document digitally via 'digital signature.' *Acrobat Reader* will step you through the process of creating a digital signature. Once completed, save the document.

3. Point Device Configuration Survey

There are three areas of the Point Device Configuration Survey that you need to complete:

- 1. The "Company Information' section at the top of page 1;
- 2. In the middle of page 2, in the "Information for Estate Management Customer ID" section, you need to enter your "Login Name." NB: "WordStock CCA Help," along with our phone number and email address, should already be entered as the "Key Contact" for Point/Verifone/EMV issues. Your "Login Name", will be your WordStock Customer ID; please contact John McDowell, WordStock Support, to get your Customer ID: 800-444-7224, opt 1, or jmcdowell@wordstock.com.
- 3. On page 4, if you're going to authorize debit cards, as well as credit cards, you'll need to enter the 'debit key' that should be injected into the terminal. Email Norm Gosselin at WordStock to get your debit key: njg@wordstock.com.

When you've completed the Point Device Survey, save the file.
