Other changes are updates to replace legacy hardware that's not worth maintaining or repairing, such as old receipt or barcode printers.

Another system upgrade involves connecting WordStock to Windows®-based computers to increase the system's overall flexibility and utility.

Replacing Terminals with Computers for Connectivity

In recent years, computers have become comparable in price to the Link MC5 terminals that WordStock has used for more than a decade. Consequently, many WordStock users — and virtually all new WordStock users — are opting to use Windows®-based computers that are connected to a WordStock server, rather than terminals for their WordStock workstations.

This configuration enables you open WordStock programs on demand by clicking a WordStock icon on the Windows 'desktop'.

WordStock communicates withWindows® computers via a network communication program called "Kermit95," which is compatible with Windows® 95/98/ME, Windows® NT/2000/XP, and OS/2.

Kermit includes a graphical Dialer to configure and launch connections without complicated initialization files, macro definitions, or commands of any kind. Kermit is launched from the Dialer to make each of your connections automatically with all the appropriate settings.

Kermit's terminal emulation features include:

- Secure Telnet connections
- Displays 132-columns and various screen heights
- Copy/paste, print, searching
- Integrated mouse functions: copy-and-paste, cursor steering
- Auto-download for both Kermit and Zmodem, autoupload for Kermit transfers, and uploads as well as downloads
- Windows long filenames
- Background as well as foreground file transfer

Since you're replacing an existing workstation, rather than adding a new one, the size of your WordStock system remains the same.



Upgrading Label & Receipt Printers

The Zebra S600 barcode printer is a dedicated, state-of-the-art barcode printer, that is, it's not for printing reports. It can accommodate a full-sized roll of media within the printer, minimizing media maintenance and label contamination by airborne dust or moisture. The Zebra uses a plastic film ribbon so even very small characters are sharp and legible.

The TPM A795 receipt printer replaces the Ithaca receipt printers that WordStock sold for many years. [NB: Ithaca printers are still available on a special order basis] The A795 POS Printer is the fastest and probably the most reliable printer in its class. This very small printer offers high speed thermal and impact journal/slip/validation printing. WordStock customers who've purchased them, or seen them at tradeshows, rave about their exceptional speed, extremely low noise level, ease of paper replacement, and high-quality printing.

Adding Book Sense Gift Card Scanning



Book Sense gift cards have a magnetic strip, a readable number, and a bar code printed on the back. Ideally, you'll swipe the card through a magstripe reader, but you can also

scan its barcode or enter its number manually if scanning or magstripe reading equipment is unavailable.

If you currently use Symbol LS9100 and LS9208 barcode scanners, they can be reprogrammed to read Book Sense barcodes.

All earlier models cannot read the Book Sense barcode, so they will have to be replaced or supplemented with a new magstripe reader.

If you want to add a new scanner, the Symbol **LS9208** is designed to work with computers and sells for \$460. This scanner can also be used with a terminal but requires a connector that costs \$125, for a total terminal update cost of \$585.

Alternatively, you can extend the life of outdated Symbol LL500 scanners by adding a Magtek MS-72 magstripe reader [\$125] and using it to read Book cards. (The LL500 controller will be reprogrammed to use the MS-72)

A final alternative is to replace your current keyboard with a **Cherry 8000LPBUS** keyboard which has a built-in magstripe reader. The keyboard is for computers only, *not terminals*, and sells for \$225.

Internet Note Book Sense gift cards use the Internet for card activation, usage, and replenishment, so continuous Internet access, *i.e.*, DSL or other broadband access, is required.

Book Sense Gift Cards require WordStock's *Book Sense Interface*, which costs \$20/month.
